44 (b) In lieu of applying the registration fee of five
45 dollars (\$5) to the disabled veteran license plate category
46 provided for in subsection (a), the registration fee may be
47 applied to any license plate category in which the disabled
48 veteran qualifies to obtain a license plate. Any additional
49 fee required for a plate from a distinctive or personalized
50 license plate category shall still be required in order to
51 obtain the plate."

52 Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
53 1, 2025.
