5	Under existing law, all motor vehicle license
6	plate designs are valid for a period of at least five
7	years.
8	This bill would make all motor vehicle license
9	plate designs valid for a period of at least 10 years.

13	TO BE ENTITLED
14	AN ACT

16	Relating to motor vehicle licenses and registration; to
17	amend Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, to extend the
18	minimum validity period of motor vehicle license plate designs
19	from five years to 10 years.
20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. Section 32-6-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	"\$32-6-62
24	(a) Subject to subsection (b), all motor vehicle
25	license plate designs shall be valid for not less than <b>five</b> 10
26	years. The Commissioner of Revenue, with the approval of the
27	License Plates Legislative Oversight Committee established by
28	Section 32-6-67, may authorize a license plate design to be



- 29 valid for more than five10 years.
- 30 (b) Subsection (a) shall not affect any law which 31 designates a license plate design to be permanent."
- 32 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 33 1, 2024.
