2 3 4 SYNOPSIS:

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5 This bill would provide that it is unlawful for 6 a person to operate an unmanned aircraft system within 7 a certain area above a Department of Corrections 8 facility, to conduct surveillance of or photograph or 9 otherwise record images of a facility, or introduce or 10 attempt to introduce contraband into a facility and 11 would provide for exceptions.

12 This bill would provide for penalties for13 violations.

This bill would also provide that any unmanned aircraft system and any property, weapons, and contraband attached to or dropped from an unmanned aircraft system is subject to civil forfeiture and would provide for the procedure for forfeiture.

19 Section 111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 20 2022, prohibits a general law whose purpose or effect 21 would be to require a new or increased expenditure of 22 local funds from becoming effective with regard to a 23 local governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 24 vote unless: it comes within one of a number of 25 specified exceptions; it is approved by the affected 26 entity; or the Legislature appropriates funds, or 27 provides a local source of revenue, to the entity for 28 the purpose.



29 The purpose or effect of this bill would be to 30 require a new or increased expenditure of local funds 31 within the meaning of the section. However, the bill 32 does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective 33 34 because it comes within one of the specified exceptions 35 contained in the section. 36 37 38 39 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 40 41 AN ACT 42 43 Relating to the Department of Corrections, to add a new Article 6 to Chapter 7 of Title 13A, Code of Alabama 1975; to 44 45 provide that it is unlawful for a person to operate an 46 unmanned aircraft system over a Department of Corrections 47 facility in certain circumstances; to provide for exceptions; 48 to provide it is unlawful for a person to introduce or attempt 49 to introduce contraband into a facility; to provide penalties

for violations; to provide that any unmanned aircraft system and any property, weapons, and contraband attached to or dropped from an unmanned aircraft system is subject to civil forfeiture; and to provide for the procedure for forfeiture; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Section 111.05 of the

58 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

59 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as60 the Drone Regulation Over Alabama Prisons Act.

61 Section 2. Article 6, commencing with Section 13A-7-90, 62 is added to Chapter 7 of Title 13A, Code of Alabama 1975, to 63 read as follows:

64 Article 6

65 \$13A-7-90

For the purposes of this article, the following termshave the following meanings:

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(1) FACILITY. Any of the following:

a. Any facility, as defined in Section 14-2-1,
including existing facilities and facilities in the process of
being constructed;

b. Any real property owned or leased by the Alabama
Department of Corrections or its contractors to the outermost
conspicuous physical barrier of the real property; or

c. Any public roads within 100 yards from the outermost
conspicuous physical barrier of real property owned or leased
by the Alabama Department of Corrections or its contractors.

78 (2) OPERATE. Any of the following actions in relation79 to an unmanned aircraft system:

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a. Conducting flight operations;

81 b. Launching;

82 c. Landing or otherwise allowing an unmanned aircraft 83 system to make contact with any person or real or personal 84 property;



d. Flying;

86 e. Causing an unmanned aircraft system to drop any87 payload; or

f. Causing an unmanned aircraft system to deploy or discharge an attached weapon, firearm, explosive, destructive device, or ammunition.

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(3) PERSON. As defined in Section 13A-7-4.3.

92 (4) UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM. As defined in Section93 13A-7-4.3.

94 §13A-7-91

95 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a person may 96 not:

97 (1) Operate an unmanned aircraft system within a 98 horizontal distance of 500 feet or a vertical distance of 200 99 feet from a facility; or

100 (2) Operate an unmanned aircraft system to conduct 101 surveillance of or photograph or otherwise record images of a 102 facility.

103 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to the use of an 104 unmanned aircraft system by:

105 (1) The Alabama Department of Corrections;

106 (2) A person authorized by federal regulations to 107 operate an unmanned aircraft system and is operating the 108 system in a lawful manner and consistent with federal 109 regulations;

110 (3) The Armed Forces of the United States of America;111 (4) The Alabama National Guard; or

112 (5) Any of the following with prior written permission



113 from the Commissioner of the Department of Corrections:

a. A contractor working on behalf of the Department ofCorrections;

b. Any state or federal law enforcement agency or public safety agency responding to an emergency;

118 c. A person engaged in official emergency functions or 119 emergency management; or

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d. Any state or federal public utility.

(c) A violation of this section is a Class C felony and a person violating this section shall be fined no less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). The sentence shall include a mandatory sentence, which is not subject to suspension or probation, of imprisonment in the Department of Corrections or county jail for not less than 30 days.

127 §13A-7-92

(a) A person may not introduce or attempt to introduce
any contraband, as defined in Section 13A-10-30, into a
facility via operation of an unmanned aircraft system.

(b) A violation of this section is a Class C felony and a person violating this section shall be fined no less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). The sentence shall include a mandatory sentence, which is not subject to suspension or probation, of imprisonment in the Department of Corrections or county jail for not less than 30 days.

137 §13A-7-93

(a) A person may not introduce or attempt to introduce
any individual piece of an unmanned aircraft system into a
facility.



141 (b) A violation of this section is a Class C felony and 142 a person violating this section shall be fined no less than 143 two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). The sentence shall 144 include a mandatory sentence, which is not subject to 145 suspension or probation, of imprisonment in the Department of 146 Corrections or a county jail for not less than 30 days. \$13A-7-94 147 148 (a) The Department of Corrections may confiscate an 149 unmanned aircraft system and any property, weapons, and 150 contraband attached to or dropped from an unmanned aircraft 151 system used in violation of this article. 152 (b) Any unmanned aircraft system and any property, 153 weapons, and contraband attached to or dropped from an 154 unmanned aircraft system is subject to civil forfeiture. The 155 procedure for the seizure, forfeiture, condemnation, and disposition shall be the same as set out in Section 20-2-93. 156 157 \$13A-7-95 158 The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections shall 159 adopt regulations as necessary to implement this article. 160 Section 3. Although this bill would have as its purpose

or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime.

Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1, 2024.
