14	Section 1. (a)(1) For purposes of this section, the
15	term "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in
16	Section 40-12-240 of the Code of Alabama 1975, excluding any
17	trailer qualifying as a utility trailer.
18	(2) The Marengo County Commission may levy an
19	additional annual issuance fee, not to exceed five dollars
20	(\$5), for each motor vehicle tag issued in the county or
21	otherwise subject to ad valorem taxation by the county unless
22	specifically exempted therefrom.
23	(3) The additional fee authorized by this section shall
24	become due at the same time the state license and registration
25	fee becomes due pursuant to Section 32-6-61, provided that the
26	additional annual fee is not collected more than once in a
27	12-month period per vehicle.

- removed at the discretion of the county commission provided the removal does not affect any contractual obligation.
- 31 (b) Any person who is 65 years of age or older, upon 32 verified proof of age, shall be granted an exemption from 33 payment of the issuance fee levied pursuant to subsection (a) 34 for one motor vehicle.
- 35 (c) The funds collected pursuant to this section shall
 36 be deposited into a special fund to be held by the county
 37 commission to be distributed to the Marengo County Economic
 38 Development Authority and for improvements to the Marengo
 39 County road system as authorized by the county commission.
 40 Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to October 1,
