7	AN ACT
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9	Relating to motor vehicle registration; to amend
10	Sections 32-6-271 and 32-6-280, Code of Alabama 1975, to
11	increase the fees for volunteer and professional firefighter
12	distinctive motor vehicle license plates and to provide for
13	the distribution of the fees collected.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Sections 32-6-271 and 32-6-280, Code of
16	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
17	"\$32-6-271
18	(a) A firefighter, upon application and subject to this
19	division, may be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license
20	plate as identification as a firefighter. In addition to the
21	proper numbers, words, and insignias used on the standard
22	license plate issued for motor vehicles, the distinctive
23	plates issued to firefighters shall bear a red Maltese cross
24	emblem on each side to the left and right of the regular tag
25	numbers. The words word "Fire Fighter" should be centered at
26	the bottom of the license plate.
27	(b) In addition to any other fees provided for by law,

28 an annual additional fee of one dollar (\$1.00) ten dollars



29 (\$10) is added to the cost of the firefighter distinctive 30 license plate provided for in this division, effective January 31 1, 2022. The annual additional fee collected pursuant to this 32 section shall be distributed by each licensing official to the 33 state Comptroller, less the commission provided in Section 40-12-269(a)(1). The state Comptroller shall distribute the 34 35 total net proceeds monthly as follows: 36 (1) Fifty cents (\$.50) Fifteen percent (15%) shall be 37 deposited into a fund managed by the Alabama Joint Fire Council and shall be used for the purpose of expanding and 38 39 maintaining the Alabama Firefighter Memorial located in Tuscaloosa. 40 41 (2) Fifty cents (\$.50) Fifteen percent (15%) shall be 42 distributed to the Alabama Joint Fire Council to be used for 43 expenses associated with the Firefighter Peer Support Program. (3) Thirty-five percent (35%) shall be distributed to 44 45 the board of the Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit 46 Fund. 47 (4) Thirty-five percent (35%) shall be distributed to 48 the secretary-treasurer of the State of Alabama Firefighters 49 Emergency Relief Fund. 50 (c) The funds generated by this the additional fee in subsection (b) shall be subject to audit from either the 51 52 Department of Examiners of Public Accounts or an independent 53 certified public accountant once every three calendar years effective January 1, 2022." 54 "§32-6-280 55 56 (a) As used in this section division, the following



57 terms shall have the following meanings:

58 (1) **Professional firefighter**PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTER. means aA paid member of a paid or part-paid fire department of 59 60 a city, town, county, or other subdivision of the state, including the chief, assistant chief, warden, engineer, 61 captain, firemen firefighters, and all other officers and 62 63 employees of the department who actually engage in fire 64 fighting firefighting or rendering first aid at the scene of 65 an accident.

(2) Retired professional firefighterRETIRED 66 67 PROFESSIONAL FIREFIGHTER. means aA retired member of a paid or part-paid fire department of a city, town, county, or other 68 subdivision of the state, including the chief, assistant 69 70 chief, warden, engineer, captain, firemen firefighters, and 71 all other officers and employees of the department who actually engaged in fire fighting firefighting or rendering 72 73 first aid at the scene of an accident. Notwithstanding any 74 other provision of this division, retired professional 75 firefighter the term includes a retired professional firefighter who is a resident of this state and who has 76 77 retired from a professional fire department in another state 78 and otherwise meets the requirements of this section division.

(b) (1) Notwithstanding Sections 32-6-64, 32-6-67, and 32-6-68, a professional firefighter or a retired professional firefighter, upon application and subject to the provisions of this section division, may be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate as identification as a professional firefighter or a retired professional firefighter, and a



85 professional firefighter, upon application and subject section, may be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license 86 plate as identification as a professional firefighter. 87 88 (2) In addition to the proper numbers, words, and 89 insignias used on the standard license plate issued for motor 90 vehicles, the distinctive plates so license plate issued for a 91 retired professional firefighter shall have a design created 92 by the state association of professional firefighters in 93 coordination with the Mobile Retired Firefighters and Paramedics Association and the Tuscaloosa Retired Firefighters 94 95 Association, and the distinctive license plate so issued for a professional firefighter shall have a design created by the 96 97 state association of professional firefighters.

98 (c)(1) The distinctive license plates provided herein 99 shall be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue and shall be 100 issued through the judge of probate, license commissioner, or 101 other license issuing official of the several counties of the 102 state in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license 103 plates, and the officers shall be entitled to their regular 104 fees for the service.

105 (2) By December 1 of each year, the Firefighters' 106 Personnel Standards and Education Commission shall submit to 107 the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other 108 license issuing official of each county a list of eligible 109 professional firefighters and retired professional 110 firefighters retired from paid or part-paid fire departments under this section. The Firefighters' Personnel Standards and 111 112 Education Commission shall also add to the list any retired



113 professional firefighter retired from a paid or part-paid fire 114 department in from another state who submits proof to the commission of eligibility pursuant to this division. The 115 116 Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission 117 shall also submit to the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other license issuing official of each county 118 119 a list of eligible professional firefighters from paid or 120 part-paid fire departments.

121 (3) Any person individual who joins a paid or part-paid fire department after December 1 of any year or any person 122 123 individual who is omitted from the list prepared as described in subdivision (2) may obtain a distinctive license plate by 124 125 presenting to the license issuing official proof of his or her 126 membership in a paid or part-paid fire department by means of 127 a certificate signed by the chief of the department on a form prescribed by the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and 128 129 Education Commission.

130 (4) Upon the initial application for a retired 131 professional firefighter distinctive license plate under this 132 section, an applicant for a distinctive license plate provided 133 in this section shall present to the judge of probate, the 134 license commissioner, or other license issuing official of the 135 county, proof of his or her retirement from a fire department 136 that is included on the list provided by the Firefighters' 137 Personnel Standards and Education Commission. Proof of the person's individual's retirement from a fire department 138 included on the that list from the Firefighters' Personnel 139 140 Standards and Education Commission is not required for renewal



141 of the distinctive license plate.

142 (5) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or her 143 identification, the professional firefighter <u>or retired</u> 144 <u>professional firefighter</u> shall be issued the requested number 145 of distinctive license plates upon the payment of the regular 146 fee for license plates, as provided by law, but shall not be 147 required to pay the three dollar (\$3) fee.

148 (6) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or her 149 identification, the retired professional firefighter shall be 150 issued the requested number of distinctive license plates upon 151 the payment of the regular license fee for plates, as provided 152 by law, but shall not be required to pay the three dollar (\$3) 153 fee.

(7)(6) The distinctive license plates so issued shall 154 155 be used only upon and for personally owned, private passenger vehicles, to include station wagons and pick-up trucks, 156 157 registered in the name of the retired professional firefighter 158 or professional firefighter making application therefor, and 159 when so-issued to the applicant shall be used upon the vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plates 160 161 normally issued for the vehicle.

162 (8)a.(7)a. In addition to any other fees provided for
163 by law, an annual additional fee of oneten dollars (\$1.00)
164 (\$10) is added to the cost of the retired professional
165 firefighter and the professional firefighter distinctive
166 license plates provided for in this division, effective
167 January 1, 2022. The annual additional fee collected pursuant
168 to this section paragraph shall be distributed by each



169 licensing official to the state Comptroller, less the 170 commission provided in Section 40-12-269(a)(1). The state Comptroller shall distribute the total net proceeds monthly as 171 172 follows: 173 1. Fifty cents (\$.50) Fifteen percent (15%) shall be 174 deposited into a fund managed by the Alabama Joint Fire 175 Council and shall be used for the purpose of expanding and 176 maintaining the Alabama Firefighter Memorial located in 177 Tuscaloosa. 2. Fifty cents (\$.50) Fifteen percent (15%) shall be 178 179 distributed to the Alabama Joint Fire Council to be used for expenses associated with the Firefighter Peer Support Program. 180 181 3. Thirty-five percent (35%) shall be distributed to the board of the Alabama Firefighters Annuity and Benefit 182 183 fund. 4. Thirty-five percent (35%) shall be distributed to 184 185 the secretary-treasurer of the State of Alabama Firefighters 186 Emergency Relief Fund. 187 b. The funds generated by this the additional fee shall be subject to audit from either the Department of Examiners of 188 189 Public Accounts or an independent certified public accountant 190 once every three calendar years effective January 1, 2022. 191 (9) (8) Anyone who is proven to have either falsely obtained or certified an individual to obtain a distinctive 192 193 professional firefighter or retired professional firefighter 194 license plate or a distinctive professional firefighter license plate shall be quilty of a Class C misdemeanor, and 195 196 upon conviction, shall be punished according to law.



197 (d) Retired professional firefighters firefighter 198 distinctive license plates and professional firefighter distinctive license plates as provided by this section shall 199 200 be prepared and furnished for the licensing year commencing 201 January 1, 2012, and thereafter as is provided by law for the 202 issuance of other license plates. Professional firefighters 203 distinctive license plates as provided by this section shall be prepared and furnished for the licensing year commencing 204 January 1, 2016, and thereafter as is provided by law for the 205 issuance of other license plates. 206 207 (e) The Department of Revenue may adopt any rules necessary to administer this section division." 208 209 Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
