4	SYNOPSIS:
5	This bill would establish a distinctive license
6	plate for military combat action and would establish
7	eligibility for individuals who participated in active
8	duty combat action while serving in the United States
9	Armed Forces, and received a combat medal or combat
10	badge.
11	This bill would also provide a criminal penalty
12	for anyone who falsely obtains a distinctive military
13	combat action special license plate.

20	Relating to motor vehicle registrations and license
21	plates; to add Section 32-6-354 to the Code of Alabama 1975,
22	to establish a combat action special license plate; and to
23	provide a criminal penalty for falsely obtaining a military
24	combat action special license plate.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section $32-6-354$ is added to the Code of
27	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

29 (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, a distinctive license plate category shall be 30 31 established for motor vehicle owners who served in a component 32 of the United States Armed Forces and received the Combat 33 Action Ribbon, Combat Infantry Badge, Combat Action Badge, 34 Combat Medical Badge, Combat Action Medal, or Air Force Combat Action Medal. The distinctive license plates shall be issued, 35 36 printed, and processed in the same manner as other distinctive tags as provided in this chapter. The eligible U.S. service 37 member shall make application to the judge of probate or other 38 39 county license plate issuing official in his or her county of 40 residence and shall present to the county license plate issuing official one of the following documents, medals, or 41 42 awards as proof of eligibility:

43 (1) A DD Form 214 stating that the service member
44 served in a combat theater and received awards or ribbons that
45 indicate combat experience.

46 (2) A copy of the certificate which accompanied the
47 service medal or ribbon signifying the participation of the
48 service member in the combat action.

49 (3) The combat action ribbon, combat infantry badge,
50 combat action badge, combat medical badge, combat action
51 medal, or air force combat action medal.

52 (b) When the service member presents satisfactory proof 53 to the county license plate issuing official of his or her 54 combat experience, the service member shall be issued the 55 requested number of distinctive license plates upon the 56 payment of the regular license fee for the plates, as provided

57 by law, and payment of the additional fee of three dollars 58 (\$3) for each plate issued. The service member shall pay the 59 additional fee for each license plate issued thereafter. In 60 those years in which the decal is issued, the service member 61 shall pay the regular license fee for tags as provided by law. 62 The distinctive license plates shall be used only upon and for 63 personally owned, private passenger vehicles, to include 64 station wagons and pickup trucks, registered in the name of the service member making application, and when issued to the 65 applicant shall be used upon the vehicle for which issued in 66 67 lieu of the standard license plates normally issued for the vehicle. The distinctive license plate authorized by this 68 section shall be as follows: 69 70 (1) Combat Action Ribbon (CAR) designated by either: 71 a. USMC (EGA) emblem, "Emblem of the United States Marine Corps"; 72 73 b. United States Navy, "Emblem of the United States

74 Navy"; or

75 c. Coast Guard, "Seal of the United States Coast 76 Guard."

77 (2) Combat Infantryman Badge (CIB) designated with the
78 U.S. Army service mark, "Army Military service mark."

(3) Combat Action Badge (CAB) designated with the U.S.
Army service mark, "Army Military service mark," or vis-a-vis
the alternate, "Combat Medical Badge" (CMB).

82 (4) Air Force Combat Action Medal (CAM), United States
83 Space Force Combat Action Medal (CAM) designated by either:
84 a. U.S. Air Force (USAF), "Emblem of the United States



85 Air Force"; or

b. U.S. Space Force Delta logo, "U.S. Space Force."
(c) The designation will be placed to the left of the
plate identification number space and underneath the proper
branch insignia logo for each respective award or medal.

90 (d) The plate shall indicate in bold print at the 91 center bottom of the plate space under the numbering in bright 92 white, "COMBAT VETERAN."

93 (e) This section does not disqualify disabled veterans 94 who are eligible under the current guidelines to have the 95 letters "DV" placed under the combat insignia in smaller 96 print.

(f) The distinctive plate may not be personalized.

98 (g) The distinctive license plate shall not be 99 transferred between motor vehicle owners and shall be subject 100 to the same provisions of law related to the transferring of 101 distinctive motor vehicle license plates provided in Section 102 32-6-154 or as otherwise provided by law or rule of the 103 Department of Revenue.

(h) Any individual who is proven to have falsely obtained or falsely certified an individual to obtain a combat action distinctive license plate issued under this section shall be guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.

108 (i) The Department of Revenue may adopt rules to109 administer this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 111 1, 2025.
